The regular meeting of the Doylestown Village Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Terry Lindeman.

Mayor Terry Lindeman led us in prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to approve the Council minutes from March 16, 2022 seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: All ayes.

CLERK: Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to place and pay bills in PO #6, seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: All ayes. **ORD. 2022-09 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-10 THE RULES, REGULATIONS AND FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE RENTAL OF THE GENE DANIEL COMMUNITY CENTER.** After the first reading, Mr. Doug Nestor made a motion to have the second and third readings by title only, seconded by Mr. DJ Youngblood. Roll Call: All ayes. After the readings, Mr. Doug Nestor made a motion to pass ORD. 2022-09 seconded by Mr. DJ Youngblood. Before the roll call, Mayor asked if there were any question. Mrs. Kay Kerr did not understand why this ordinance was passing on an emergency basis. Roll Call: All ayes. **RES. 2022-12 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CHIPPEWA LOCAL SCHOOLS RENEWAL OF A 5 YEAR 1% EARNED INCOME TAX LEVY.** After the reading, Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to pass RES. 2022-12 seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: All ayes. **RES. 2022-13 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CHIPPEWA LOCAL SCHOOLS PERMANENT IMPROVEMENMTS LEVY A RATE NOT EXCEEDING ONE HALF (0.5) MILL.** After the reading, Mrs. Kay Kerr made a motion to pass RES. 2022-13 seconded by Mr. CJ Gadosik. Roll Call: All ayes. Chief Tester was here to announce that Officer Greg Sowl had resigned as he will be going to paramedic school and could no longer work here. Chief Tester thanked him for his service. Mr. Tim Smith made a motion to hire Daniel Kopinsky seconded by Mr. DJ Youngblood. Roll Call: All ayes. Mayor Lindeman swore Officer Daniel Kopinsky in.

STREETS: Elmwood Drive road repairs have been done and "No Parking" signs were installed. Next meeting April 13 at 6:00 PM.


