

Village of Doylestown, Health and Wellness Committee

Minutes of meeting for June 4, 2019, Tuesday, 5:45 P.M., at Village Hall. Members present were Mistie Ankeman, Chairman, Mayor Lindeman, and Lynett Perren. Michele Rohr, representative from Doylestown Health Care Center is an excused absence. Stephanie Shields was not in attendance.

Mistie informed the committee that she had spoken to Harold Rozak, owner of the Coffee Shop in Doylestown and a member of the THRIVE committee in town, about the plan for our committee's new endeavor "Doylestown Walks". He is in agreement that we may use the front porch of the Coffee Shop as a gathering place for the walks and that the THRIVE committee is in agreement with the plans for the community. Mistie and Mayor will contact people in the village to pass on the plans and explain these walks around town. Mistie has two pair of Cleveland Indian tickets she is willing to donate for a prize, and/or a \$250 cash prize from our committee as another prize. To get the information started we will run just a question, "Heard about the Doylestown Walks?" on the Village Cable TV channel for one week and then week two, "If you haven't heard about the Doylestown Walks---then give the information about the walks on Thursday nights." Mayor will ask Kristen to do this for us. We discussed the possibility of giving out lanyards or pedometers to the first 100 people to register for the walks. In Orrville, if it rains on walk night, the people may register that night and walk at any other time of their choice. Is this something we might like to include for our walks? We may be able to give out up to date information about the walks on the Doylestown Facebook page or the THRIVE Facebook site. We discussed that Doylestown Health Care Center and Post Newspaper were our corporate sponsors for the Health Fairs and that maybe we could contact them to be sponsors for a "Doylestown Walks" banner, using the doughboy as a logo on the banner to advertise the walks.

Mistie made a motion to accept the minutes of our May 9, 2019 meeting, and Mayor seconded the motion. Minutes were approved unanimously.

Mayor made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:05 P.M. and Mistie seconded the motion. All approved. The meeting scheduled for June 25th, 2019 will not be held as planned. The next scheduled meeting will be July 9, 2019, Tuesday, at Village Hall.
