

Streets Committee Meeting  
June 16, 2020 at Village Hall

Meeting began at 7:01 with Mayor Lindeman, DJ Youngblood, Doug Nestor, Brett Shaw and Kay Kerr. Chief Tester joined the meeting.

Doug moved and Terry seconded a motion to pass the February 2020 minutes. Motion passed. We did not meet in March, April and May 2020 due to Covid 19.

Brett will ask a steel siding company for a quote at the street garage.

It took 2 weeks to pick up the brush this month due to a storm and high volume.

We need pipe and basins for Maple St. Huffman storm drain work is done. We need to hire a company to jet the storm water system at Circle Dr and Cleveland St.

Street sweeping was done in May and can be cancelled for Aug. We will not be having the festival this year.

W Marion/Park Dr parking lot needs a skim coat of lime stone before we add a drain and pave next year.

At 585 and Gates St the sign will be mounted in the next week. Then the water and electric lines need to be put in.

More discussion after research will occur concerning our cemetery.

Mayor moved and DJ seconded a motion to ask the Silver Creek developer to finish phases 2 and 3 and post a bond to clean the ponds if they silt up from work in phases 2 and 3 before the village will accept the 2 retention ponds in phases 1. Motion passed.

We will be hiring a new employee to start in early August.

We need to do more research on school signs.

Survey work is being done concerning potential sidewalks on Maple St.

Still researching the traffic light on N Portage.

Our planner is putting the details together for a storm water map of our village.

Mayor moved and Doug seconded a motion to ask for \$45,000 capital money be set aside in 2020 and 2021 budget to be able to buy a \$90,000 dump truck in 2022. Motion passed.

Mayor moved and Doug seconded a motion to explore abandoning alleys with our solicitor.  
Motion passed.

Paving and patching on W Cleckner to be researched.

Mayor moved and Doug seconded a motion to accept the Buckeye Sealcoating bid to repair  
Park Dr from College to Frederick and College Dr from Park to Portage.

DJ moved and Mayor seconded a motion to end the meeting at 7:57 p.m. Next meeting: July  
21.
