



VILLAGE OF DOYLESTOWN TAX INFORMATION SHEET

Need help with your Village of Doylestown return?

We will be happy to prepare your VOD return for you at no cost. You will need to bring in your W-2's, and if you file a Schedule C,E,F, have miscellaneous or gambling income, we will need documentation of those as well. No appointment is necessary, but we request that you come in between 9:00 am and 3:30 pm prior to the filing due date to avoid waiting in line. Call 330-658-2181 ext. 1102 for questions.

Who must file?

The Village of Doylestown has earnings taxes of 2.0% that applies to all who live, work or operate a business within the village.

We have a mandatory filing, so all residents over the age of 18 are required to file whether tax is due or not unless they are on file as "Retired-No Earned Income. You can request this change of status once you have filed with this office for two consecutive years showing no earned income on your Federal 1040 front page.

All non-residents who work in the Village of Doylestown but were not fully withheld by their employer are required to file.

All non-residents engaged in a business within the Village who have made sales, performed services or own rental property must file a return whether or not a tax is due.

When to File

Individual Returns:	On or before April 15 th
Business Returns:	One or before April 15 th or the 15 th day of the 4 th month following the end of the fiscal year.
Withholding Reconciliations:	On or before February 28 th

*If the due date falls on a weekend or a federal holiday, the due date will be the following business day. We will follow the federal tax deadline.

Extensions

An extension for filing the annual Village of Doylestown income tax return may be requested by any business or individual by submitting a written request or providing a copy of the Federal extension to the Tax Office on or before the due date for filing the return. The extension, if granted, only extends the filing date of the return. The extension does not extend the due date for payment of the tax. Payments are due on or before April 15th each year.

School District Tax

The code for the Chippewa Local School District tax is 8501. This is a State of Ohio tax and is filed directly to the State of Ohio on Form SD 100, which can be found at www.tax.ohio.gov.
